Insights into how Barbara and Richard came to be standing here today

They found each other on a dating site (seniorpeoplemeet.com), via which Barbara contacted Richard to suggest a rendezvous. They met for the first time at Romeo's café in New Haven on the evening of August 14, 2010. Both expecting the meeting to be brief and casual, they ended up talking for four hours, well after Romeo's had closed.

They were unable to see each other again for nearly two weeks. Barbara traveled across the country, a trip that included a California odyssey with her brother, Joel, and his wife, Pam. Overlapping with this, Richard visited family in Brooklyn and Evanston, IL. Knowing about the delay, they immediately began an e-mail correspondence, in the next two weeks exchanging 101 e-mails. Many of these messages inserted responses to earlier messages to produce an increasingly complex conversation.

They will now read selections from this early e-mail. Most of the material comes from a lengthy exchange that began August 15 and lasted several days. If the sequence sometimes seems confusing, it's because the reading presents one statement from the initial e-mail and goes through a series of replies to replies (to replies to...) before returning to the next statement in the original e-mail.
