Jonathan Eric ("Rick") Beitch died suddenly in Dallas on August 5, at the age of 47. Someone with a zest for life, a compassion for all human beings, a champion for the underdog (both human and canine), an eloquent spokesperson for causes he believed were worth fighting for, and a doggedly loyal family member, Rick left behind and will be sorely missed by his wife Sandra Palomino, his daughter Miranda Palomino-Beitch, his newborn grandson Jacob Isaiah Eagins, and his mother Barbara Beitch, as well as other family members including cousins, aunts and uncles, nieces and nephews, as well as numerous friends who cared deeply for him.
